Grape Variety: 100% Fiano

Region of Production: Barossa Valley (Estate Grown).

Winemaking Notes:

Fiano is gently aromatic and blessed with beautiful natural acidity. We work hard aiming to play to these strengths, so gently press the fruit, hold it at low temperature to let it settle, then ferment the clean juice slowly at cool temperature. After fermentation we keep it simple, to ensure a light, crisp aromatic style.

Vineyard Report:

Gently picked early in the morning for fresh acidity and lively fruit. Vintage 2025 was an early one with no rain interruptions and great acidity.

Picking Season: February 2025

Alcohol: 12.5%

Sugar Residual: 0.9 g/l

T.A. (Acidity): 6.7 g/l

Tasting Note:

Fiano is an exciting white hailing from the Italian coastal region of Campania in southern Italy and Sicily and thrives in moderate to warm dry climates. Our Western Ridge soils are ideal for this relative newcomer. It's fresh, bright and vibrant. A great wine for summer sessions with aromas of stone fruits and citrus-like acidity... that guarantees that 'second glass' appeal!
