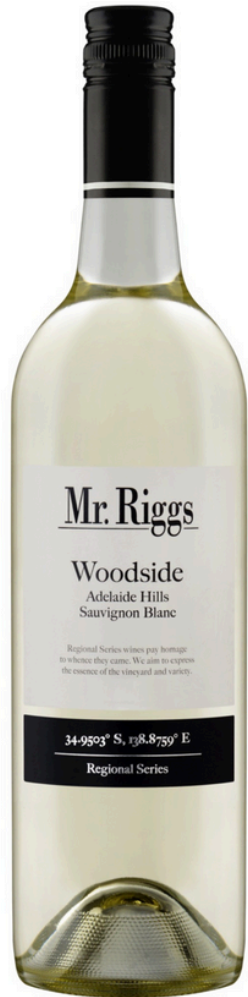

2025 Mr. Riggs Woodside Sauvignon Blanc

The Regional Series is all about paying homage to whence they came. After all, the aim of all Mr. Riggs wines is to express the essence of the vineyard and varieties.

History

'I have quite a long connection with Sauvignon Blanc, from working with the variety in Bordeaux in 1986 to producing it while working as head wine maker at Wirra Wirra from 1988-2001. I always thought the flavour profile was incredible and here we are in my 24th vintage at Mr. Riggs with a Mr. Riggs Adelaide Hills Sauvignon Blanc.' - Ben Riggs

Vineyard

The Adelaide Hills is one of Australia's most diverse wine regions, with variations in altitude, climate, and soil that contribute to the region's distinctive cool-climate wines. In the township of Woodside, vineyards are planted across gently rolling slopes, where cooler temperatures and well-drained soils support slow, balanced ripening. Our fruit is sourced from several blocks with slightly different aspects and ripening periods, allowing us to blend to a desired style.

Vintage

The 2025 vintage in Adelaide Hills was characterised by one of the earliest starts to vintage in recent memory. It was a season of extremes, including a frost in spring 2024 and summer heat with very dry conditions, leading to harvest in early February. The cool nights in the Adelaide Hills helped preserve natural acidity with this vintage of Sauvignon Blanc exhibiting fresh citrus notes and clean, concentrated flavors.

Winemaking

Fruit for the Woodside Sauvignon Blanc was machine harvested in the early hours of the morning. Fruit is crushed and free run with no pressings, and the juice is then clarified and fermented with two aromatic yeast strains. The wine spends a short time on lees until filtration and then bottling.

Tasting Note

A fresh and floral Sauvignon Blanc with a zesty passionfruit and grapefruit nose, the mid palate is wonderfully textured with citrus pith and a long crisp finish. A perfect starter for a drink in the sun with friends. Pair with your favourite seafood dish.
