The Wine

Each year, we have access to three really old Mataro vineyards to make this wine. However, when deciding on the final blend for this wine, the best wine we could make came from one single vineyard, believed to be nearly 160 years of age. It has been in the same family for five generations. We only make this wine when the climatic conditions allow us to do so. This release really shows what truly great Mataro should smell and taste like: great aromas of eucalypt, and Chinese five spice, jump out of the glass. The palate is medium bodied, but has great tannin extracted from the grape skins.

A bean bag, watching the footy on TV, and Peking duck pancakes.
